

Honours Arts & Science and Linguistics

ADMISSION

Completion of Arts & Science I with a grade point average of at least 6.0, including an average of at least 5.0 in Linguistics 1A03 and 1AA3.

Notes:

1. Nine units from the following list are required: ARTSSCI 3A06, 3B03, 3BB3, one of 3L03/3S03. Students who choose to take ARTSSCI 3L03 or 3S03 may only use one of those courses towards satisfying 3 units of the requirement. Students are encouraged, however, to take additional units from this list as an elective.
2. Nine units of Upper-Level Inquiry beyond Level I are required. Additional units of Upper-Level Inquiry may be included as an elective with the permission of the Director. Upper-Level Inquiry courses are: ARTSSCI 3CL3, 3CU3, 3EH3, 3GJ3, 3TR3, 4CA3, 4CB3, 4CD3, 4CF3, 4CI3, 4CP3, 4CT3, 4EP3, 4HS3, 4VC3.
3. Students must include LINGUIST 2D03 in Level II or III of their program in order to take any Level IV seminars in Linguistics. Students from other programs must have completed an equivalent research methods course.
4. Students registered in Level IV of a Combined Honours Linguistics program with a grade point average of at least 9.0 may apply for the Honours Thesis course (LINGUIST 4Y06) where they would conduct an individual research project under the supervision of a faculty member.
5. Students are required to complete 12 units of a language other than English, either in one or two languages. Please note that some languages only have 3 or 6 units of study available. Courses taught in English do not satisfy this requirement. The following Languages are offered at McMaster:
 - Romance Languages:** French, Italian, Spanish
 - Classical Languages:** Greek, Latin, Sanskrit
 - Other Indo-European Languages:** German, Polish, Russian
 - Non Indo-European Languages:** American Sign Language, Arabic, Cayuga, Chinese (Mandarin), Hebrew, Inuktitut, Japanese, Mohawk, Ojibwe
6. One of ARTSSCI 4A06 or 4C06 may be taken as an elective.

3 units Level IV Linguistics, excluding LINGUIST 4SL3, 4TE3, 4Y06

12 units from a Language other than English above Level I (in either one or two languages)
