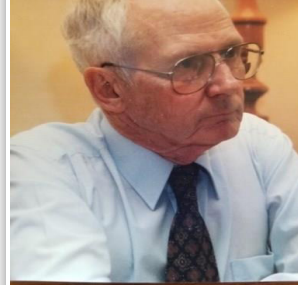
Note from Dr. Jean Wilson, Director of Arts & Science:

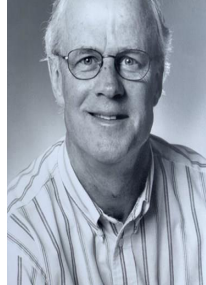
Special thanks to everyone who sent in tributes to Herb Jenkins and/or Bob Hudspith.

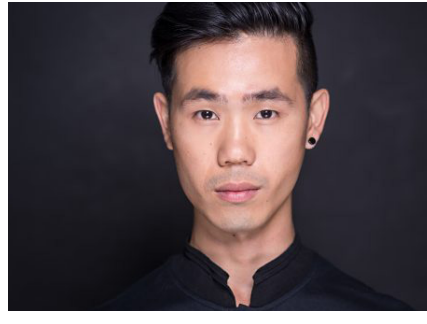

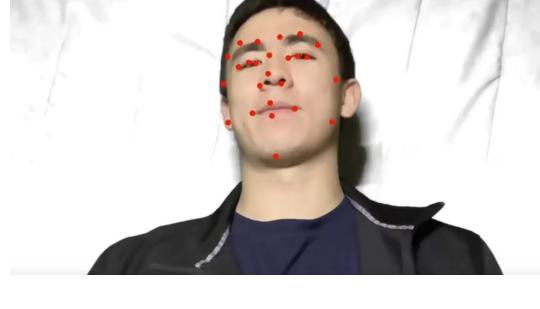

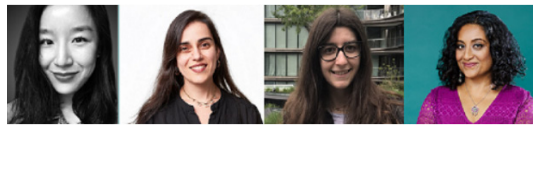
